Dear Parent/Guardian of a Math I Student,

As we begin a new school year, we are looking forward to utilizing Canvas, which is best described as a virtual learning environment. Within Canvas, your student will have access to the class website for each course in which they are enrolled during the Fall semester. Currently, only the student has access to their homepage, but in the coming months, parents and guardians will have their own access codes as well. In the meantime, ask your student to show you how to access their Canvas page.

The site for this class utilizes an online agenda to record the material which was covered in class each day. It includes a description of all topics discussed, assessments given, work assigned and reminders about upcoming events related to the course. Please encourage your student to review the agenda frequently, especially if they miss a day of class. The web page is updated daily to ensure the most up-to-date information is readily available. In addition to an online agenda, a hard-copy version of the information is also available in our classroom. Students who do not have internet access or who are unable to print the material at home may retrieve their missing work upon returning to the class.

Also remember you may review your student's progress report and grade at any time via PowerSchools.
